Sir Henry Thompson of Marston & York; LM of York 1663; Gov. of Merchant Adventurers 1667-72; MP York 1673, 1679, 1681; purchased Escrick 1668; d. Marston 1683

= Jane Newton d. 1661

Sir Edward Thompson of Sheriff Hutton; MP York r689-1701; d. 1701

Sir Stephen Thompson of Kirby Hall, Ouseburn ?1635-91

Mary Beilby of Wetherby d. Escrick 1727

= Henry Thompson; LM of York 1699; MP 1690 & 1695; built Escrick Park; d. Escrick 1700

Richard Thompson; Gov. of Merchant Adventurers; d. 1743

Beilby Thompson; Sheriff of Yorks. 1731; 1686-1750

= Sarah D'Arcy Dawes; widow of Sir D'Arcy Dawes, son of Sir Wm. Dawes Ab. of York 1713-24; d. 1773

Beilby Thompson; MP Hedon 1768-80 & 1790-96; MP Thirsk 1780-84; 1742-99

= Sir Robert Lawley of Canwell, Staffs.; MP Warwicks.; 1736-93

Richard Thompson; Sheriff of Yorks. 1801; 1744-1820

= Sir Robert Lawley; 1st Baron Wenlock 1831; d. 1834

Paul Beilby Thompson; MP Wenlock; 1st Baron Wenlock (2nd creation) 1839; 1784-1852

= Caroline Neville 1792-1868

Elizabeth Grosvenor = Richard Lawley; MP Pontefract; 2nd Baron Wenlock 1818-80

Stephen Willoughby Lawley; Rector of Escrick 1848-68; 1823-1905

Constance Lascelles 1852-1932 = Beilby Lawley; 3rd Baron Wenlock; Gov. of Madras 1891-96; 1849-1912

4 daughters & 5 sons, of whom Richard, Algernon & Arthur became respectively 4th, 5th & 6th Barons Wenlock. Title became extinct on d. of Arthur in 1932
