



Anne Wharton née Lloyd (1712-1789)



Anne Lloyd was born in 1712, the daughter of William Lloyd Chancellor of the Diocese of Worcester, and grand-daughter of William Lloyd, Bishop of Worcester. Her mother was Jane Thompson, possibly a member of the Thompson family of Escrick Park.

In September 1749 she married Richard Wharton Esq of Durham at Bafferton church, Yorkshire.

Their son Robert, became Chancellor of Lincoln. Anne Wharton died at Escrick in 1789 aged seventy-seven.
